Can you please advise us as to whether Lambeth's CAAC has given advice concerning the Streatham Common Conservation Area in general and on this planning application in particular.

Can you also please give me the name and address of the Secretary and all the members.

I would be grateful if you could explain how and what your team is responsible for, how the application is dealt with by Conservation and Planning, what matters concern each and when each application will be considered, since we will want to make representations to both organisations.

Number 11a Streatham Common South sits in a large garden full of mature trees within the Conservation Area and the house itself has a very unusual copper roof which along with the whole open area should be conserved. How can we make this point and have the roof conserved?
